2. Glue the middle spine of "Would you like green eggs and ham..." to the middle of your lapbook.

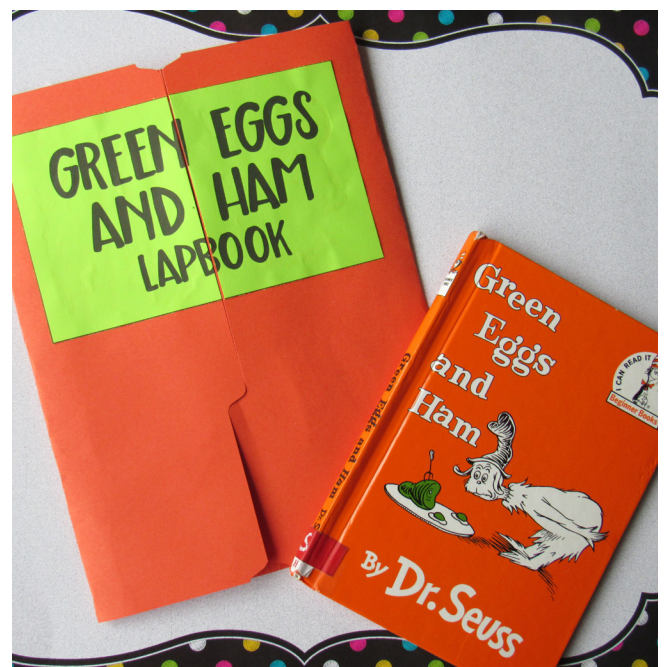
3. Lift each flap and glue the correct item below each flap.

3. Cut out the four rhyming word envelopes. Glue these to the left side of your lapbook. Stick the correct rhyming words in each folder.

4. Cut out the "Who is the Author" box. Write the author's name in the box. Glue to the top right of your folder.

5. Cut out the "My Sight Words" envelope pocket and the words to go in there. Use them as flashcards and say each word aloud before placing them in the pocket.

6. Cut out the cover. Cut in half and Glue the left side to the left of the file folder cover. Glue the right to the right side of the file folder.
