


## Ideas for Winter

- 4. Create a sculpture, much like a snowman. Use spray or squirt bottles filled with water and food coloring to decorate it.
- 5. Make icicle art. Fill ice cube trays, muffin trays, or molds with water and food coloring. Use the cubes to create art.
- 6. Bake bread together.
- 7. Study animals that hibernate.
- 8. Celebrate holidays around the world.

- 10. Make bird feeders for Winter birds.

- 25. Bake and decorate gingerbread cookies.


